LAUSD Teachers

You have two options for receiving credit

LAUSD teachers may choose to receive either

- University credit through California State University, Chico.
- Or Salary Point Credit through LAUSD

University credit will transfer if you move to another district but most districts do not accept the salary point classes from other districts. The fee for university credit is \$60. If you choose the university option you will need to complete five seminars. Salary point credit now requires six seminars. One university unit is equal to one salary point in terms of receiving credit toward advancing on the salary point schedule.

Participation in the live seminar is required for either credit options.

Effective April 1, 2013 Please note:

The requirements for LAUSD salary point credit have changed. The requirements for University credit through Cal State Chico remain the same. If you choose salary point credit you will need to complete six seminars.

Salary point Credit

For LAUSD Salary point credit you will need to complete six seminars to earn the 30 hours required by the contract. This is a change from the previous requirement where participants completed five seminars and additional written work to earn one salary point.

Information for Submitting Documentation for Both University and Salary Point Credit.

Participants who choose the university route for credit will send their transcript in to LAUSD Salary Allocation on the U form. Those who choose salary point credit must send 6 seminar verification letters and the NA form. Both U and NA forms are available at lausdsalary.net. The forms you download include additional information and the correct mailing address for submission.
