




# Effective Professional Development Improves Student Achievement

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


Expert “live modeling” is key to a teacher understanding how to apply a skill in the classroom.

need “live modeling” and active practice to transfer a new skill into the classroom.




Teachers’ exposure to a concept should be active and engaged where participation provides practice.
